On March 3, 2020, Officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Patrick Barry, age 22, of 23 Clark Circle, Pelham, New Hampshire and charged him with Consolidated Theft by Unauthorized Taking or Transfer, Class B Felony, Theft by Deception, Class A Misdemeanor, and Receiving Stolen Property, Class A Misdemeanor.

On March 3, 2020, Officers responded to TradeLand located at 293 Daniel Webster Highway in Nashua for the report of a theft. The suspect, later identified as Patrick Barry, was located a short time later at a nearby business attempting to pawn the stolen merchandise. Upon further investigation, it was discovered that Barry had stolen additional items from TradeLand on a previous dates and also pawned that merchandise. The total combined value of the items stolen was value in excess of \$1,000.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Each Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in jail, exclusive of fines. Barry was released on personal recognizance bail pending his arraignment in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – Southern District on March 19, 2020.
