On January 8, 2020 at approximately 1:17pm, members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Jason Warren, age 19, of 26 Cedar Street Apt A, Nashua, New Hampshire for Registration of Online Identifiers, Class B Felony.

On September 9, 2019, officers responded to a city residence for a possible violation of bail conditions. During this call, a reporting party advised they were contacted through Instagram by an unknown account and believed it to be Jason Warren. It was learned that Warren is a registered sex offender in the state of New Hampshire is required to contact the Nashua Police Department within 5 business days of any changes to his sex offender registry form.

Through investigation Warren was identified as the subject who created the said Instagram account and failed to contact the Nashua Police Department regarding his online identifier within 5 business days. An arrest warrant was subsequently obtained for Warren. Warren was located at his residence and subsequently placed under arrest.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Warren was transported and held at the Hillsborough County House of Corrections on \$200 cash or surety bail and was scheduled to appear at arraignment at the Hillsborough Superior Court-South on January 9, 2020.
