On March 2, 2020 at approximately 10:40am, members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested David Dion, age 40, of 2.5 Spalding Street, Nashua, New Hampshire for two counts of Registration of Online Identifiers, Class B Felony.

On January 30, 2020 detectives from the Special Investigation Division received information that David Dion had created a Plenty of Fish account along with a new email address and failed to inform the Nashua Police Department regarding this information. Detectives learned Dion is a registered sex offender in the State of New Hampshire and is required to contact the Nashua Police Department within 5 business days of any changes to his sex offender registry form.

Detectives subsequently obtained an arrest warrant for Dion charging him with Registration of Online Identifiers, Class B Felony. Dion was later located and placed under arrest.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Dion was released on Personal Recognizance and is scheduled to appear at arraignment at the Hillsborough Superior Court-South on March 12, 2020.
