On 23 November 2013, at approximately 10:30 p.m., members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Division responded to 39 Congress Street, apartment 24, for the report of shots fired. Upon their arrival they discovered that two adults had been struck by one bullet as a result of an accidental discharge. An adult male, who resides in New York, was breaking down a handgun which was still loaded. The weapon was fired and a bullet went through his hand and then into the upper leg of an adult female. The adult female is a resident of the Congress Street address.

Both parties were transported to local hospitals with non life threatening injuries. The male party was later transported to the Lahey Clinic in Burlington, MA.

This is an ongoing investigation and charges are expected to be filed against the male party involved in this incident.

No other injuries were reported.
