In January of 2020, members of the New Hampshire Internet Crimes Against Children (NH ICAC) Task Force received a cyber-tip which was furthered by members of the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division.

As a result of the investigation, on January 30, 2020 at 3:37 P.M., members of the Uniform Field Operations Bureau, arrested Wayne P. Campbell, age 55, of Nashua, New Hampshire. Campbell is charged with five (5) counts of Possession of Child Sexual Abuse Images, Class B Felony.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Campbell was held on \$500 cash bail and is scheduled to be arraigned in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South on January 31, 2020.

The Nashua Police Department was assisted in this investigation by members of the Rhode Island State Police Computer Crimes Unit. The Nashua Police Department is also an affiliate of the Internet Crimes against Children (ICAC) Task Force, working to combat child exploitation in New Hampshire.
