On Thursday, August 6, 2020 at approximately 8:12 PM, Officers from the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing (POP) Unit arrested Samuel Parodi, age 39, of No Fixed Address, Nashua, NH 03060, charging him with Possession of a Controlled Drug (Heroin/Fentanyl), Subsequent Offense, Class A Felony, contrary to New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated (RSA) 318-B:2 and Violation of Probation or Parole, contrary to New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated (RSA) 504-A:4.

On August 6, 2020, Officers from the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing (POP) Unit responded to 71 Temple Street to assist New Hampshire Probation/Parole Officers with a check on Parodi who had not been reporting to probation as court-ordered. Parodi was found to be in possession of a quantity of heroin and/or Fentanyl stored on his person.

A Class A Felony is punishable by a term of imprisonment in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Parodi was transferred to the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections with an arraignment date of Friday, August 7, 2020 at the Hillsborough County Superior Court – Southern District.
