On January 01, 2020 at approximately 2:31 am, officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested James Carignan III, age 24, of Merrimack, NH on two outstanding arrest warrants. The arrest warrants stem from two separate incidents that occurred in Nashua.

In March 2017 the Nashua Police Department began an investigation into the internal thefts of multiple smart phones from Verizon Wireless at 310 Daniel Webster Highway in Nashua. It was determined that while employed by Verizon Wireless between December 2016 and January 2017 he created fictitious transactions in order to obtain multiple smart phones with a total loss in excess of \$1,500.00. Detectives obtained an arrest warrant stemming from this incident charging Carignan with Theft by Deception, class A felony.

In April 2017 officers responded to a Nashua residence for the report of a domestic assault. It was reported that Carignan bit a female during an altercation and fled prior to the arrival of police. Patrol officers obtained an arrest warrant stemming from this incident charging Carignan with Domestic Violence Simple Assault, class A Misdemeanor.

Carignan's bail was set at \$200.00 cash. Carignan was scheduled to be arraigned in the 9th Circuit – District Division – Nashua Court on January 3, 2020. A class A felony is punishable by up to fifteen years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A class A misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections, exclusive of fines.
