On February 2, 2020 at approximately 11:23pm, members of the Nashua Police Department Uniformed Field Operations Bureau arrested Juan Rivera-Ortiz, age 36, of 9 Terrace Street Apt. 1 Nashua, New Hampshire for; two counts of Second Degree Assault- Domestic Violence, Class B Felonies; Falsifying Physical Evidence, a Class B Felony; and Criminal Mischief, a Class A Misdemeanor.

On February 2, 2020 patrol officers responded to the Southern New Hampshire Medical Center in Nashua, NH, for the report of an assault. Upon arrival officers learned that a domestic dispute had taken place at 9 Terrace Street, Nashua, NH earlier in the night. Officers established Rivera-Ortiz as an involved party and he was arrested by patrol officers. During transport to the Police Department Rivera-Ortiz caused damage to a Nashua Police cruiser.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to 1 year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Rivera-Ortiz was held on preventative detention and is scheduled to appear at arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on February 3, 2020.
