On January 28, 2020, Officers with the Manchester Police Department assisted the Nashua Police Department by arresting Hernan Rijos Calderon, age 31, of 545 Central Street, apt. 1, Manchester, New Hampshire on an arrest warrant for Reckless Conduct with a Deadly Weapon - Class B Felony. Rijos Calderon was additionally charged with two more counts of Reckless Conduct with a Deadly Weapon – Class B Felony, Convicted Felons – Class B Felony and two counts of Criminal Mischief – Class B Felony.

On January 25, 2020 at approximately 1:50 AM, members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to a shots fired call in the area of 57 Palm Street in Nashua. There were no injuries reported as a result of the shots fired. It was discovered that multiple gunshots had been fired from a moving vehicle causing damage to the multi-apartment building at 57 Palm Street. Two of these rounds were discovered to have stuck the building and penetrated into two separate occupied apartments. Detectives with the Criminal Investigation Division furthered the investigation and identified Hernan Rijos Calderon as being responsible for this incident. A criminal record check revealed Rijos Calderon has a previous felony conviction prohibiting him from possessing a firearm. On January 26, 2020 Detectives obtained an arrest warrant charging Hernan Rijos Calderon with the Reckless Conduct with a Deadly Weapon.

Hernan Rijos Calderon was held on preventative detention, transported to the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections and is scheduled to be arraigned on January 29, 2020 at the Hillsborough County Superior Court- South in Nashua.
