On February 11, 2020 at approximately 5:02 pm, members of the Nashua Police Department arrested Jamel Flemming, age 46, of 1536 St. Johns Place #3F, Brooklyn, New York. Flemming is charged with Theft by Unauthorized Taking or Transfer, Class A Felony.

On November 12, 2019, Officers responded to Macy's at 310 Daniel Webster Highway in Nashua for a report of a theft. It was determined that on November 7, 2019 Fleming participated in the theft of various fragrances, valued at approximately \$35,000.00, from the business. The investigation was furthered by Detectives and an arrest warrant was issued. Flemming was taken into custody as a Fugitive from Justice on February 3, 2019 by the New York City Police Department. He subsequently waived extradition and was transported back to New Hampshire with the assistance of the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Flemming is currently being held on preventative detention at the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections, pending his arraignment on February 12, 2020 at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South.
