On June 03, 2020 at 3:47 P.M., members of the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing (POP) Unit, arrested Christopher Gempp, age 36, of Derry, New Hampshire. Gempp is charged with Certain Uses of Computer Services Prohibited, Class B Felony and Attempted Felonious Sexual Assault, Class B Felony.

In April of 2020, members of the Special Investigations Division began an investigation into the sexual exploitation of children on the internet where a subject, identified as Gempp was communicating with a person he believed to be a child. As a result of the investigation on June 03, 2020, Gempp was arrested in Nashua.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Gempp was held on \$5,000 cash or surety bail and is scheduled to be arraigned in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South on June 04, 2020.

The Nashua Police Department is an affiliate of the Internet Crimes against Children (ICAC) Task Force, working to combat child exploitation in New Hampshire.
