On January 7, 2020 at approximately 6:42 p.m., members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Amina Gordon, age 20, of 3815 Putnam Avenue West, Apartment 2C, New York, New York. Gordon was ultimately charged with Attempted Theft by Deception, Theft by Deception, and two counts of Identify Fraud, all Class A Felonies.

On January 7, 2020 at 5:44 p.m., officers responded to Verizon Wireless at 310 Daniel Webster Highway in Nashua for a fraud in progress. Contact was made with Gordon on scene and it was determined Gordon attempted to fraudulently obtain multiple cell phones with a total value in excess of \$1,500 by opening an account using the identity of another individual.

Detectives furthered this investigation and determined earlier in the evening Gordon entered another Verizon Wireless at 258 Daniel Webster Highway in Nashua and successfully fraudulently obtained multiple cell phones with a total value in excess of \$1,500 by opening an account using the identity of second victim.

Gordon was released on \$1,000.00 cash bail and is scheduled to be arraigned at the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South on January 23, 2020. Each Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years in State Prison, exclusive of fines.
