On January 25, 2020, at 1:06 p.m., members of the Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to Verizon Wireless, at 258 Daniel Webster Highway, Nashua, New Hampshire for a reported fraud in progress. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with Catherine Borek, age 53, of 20 Dogwood Drive, West Orange, New Jersey. After an initial investigation, Borek was placed under arrest and charged with Attempt Theft by Deception, Excess of \$1,500 - Class A Felony.

Detectives furthered this investigation and determined Borek entered the store and attempted to fraudulently obtain merchandise, valued in excess of \$1,500.

Borek was transferred to the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections as she refused bail. Borek was scheduled to be arraigned at the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South on January 27, 2020. A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years in State Prison, exclusive of fines.
