On July 17, 2020, at 5:16 p.m., Nashua Police Department Patrol Officers arrested Makayla A. Cherichel, age 22, of 90 Amherst Street, Apartment A, Nashua, New Hampshire. Cherichel was charged with one count of Theft by Unauthorized Taking, Class A Felony.

On July 17, 2020, at 4:21 p.m., Patrol Officers responded to a pet store within the city for a reported theft of a Pomeranian. Officers identified Cherichel as the person responsible for the theft and located Cherichel a short time later. Cherichel was still in possession of the Pomeranian and Officers were able to return the dog to the pet store. The Pomeranian was not harmed during this incident. The Pomeranian was valued at \$2,999.99, therefore Detectives with the Criminal Investigation Division were assigned to further the investigation.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Cherichel was released on Personal Recognizance pending her arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court–South at a later date.
