On January 7, 2020 members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Alexis Geddes, age 20, of 32 Blossom Street, Nashua, New Hampshire. On January 8, 2020 officers arrested Destiny Velazquez, age 19, of 88 Bowers Street, Nashua, New Hampshire. Both are charged with Criminal Mischief, Class B Felony, stemming from an incident that occurred in November 2019.

On November 25, 2019, officers responded to the area of Bowers Street for the report of damage to a motor vehicle. Patrol officers furthered the investigation and identified Geddes and Velazquez as being responsible for scratching the vehicle and covering it in paint. The damage was in excess of \$1,500. Arrest warrants were applied for and granted charging both Geddes and Velazquez.

A Class B felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Alexis Geddes was released on personal recognizance bail. Both were released after arrest on personal recognizance bail. Alexis Geddes is scheduled to be arraigned on January 16, 2020 at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South. Destiny Velazquez is scheduled to be arraigned on January 23, 2020 at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South.
