On April 19, 2020 at approximately 12:52 p.m., members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested, Adam Myjer, age 28, of 11 Grand Avenue, Nashua, New Hampshire. Myjer was charged with Criminal Threatening; Deadly Weapon – Class B Felony, and, Resisting Arrest or Detention – Class A Misdemeanor.

On April 19, 2020 at approximately 11:54 a.m., officers responded to the area of Grand Avenue for a dispute. It was alleged that during this dispute, Adam Myjer brandished a long-barreled firearm and directed it toward a group of individuals involved in the dispute. During initial contact with responding officers, Myjer fled into his residence, and was eventually taken into custody. Detectives furthered the investigation. As a result, it was determined that Myjer was responsible for threatening at least two individuals with a firearm while he was engaged in a verbal dispute with them. The firearm believed to be involved was recovered.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years of imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to a year of incarceration, exclusive of fines. Myjer was released on \$500.00 cash bail pending his arraignment in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South on May 28, 2020.
