On March 25, 2020 at 4:37 pm, members of the Nashua Police Department arrested Steven Elliott, age 30, of 256 Pine Street, Nashua, New Hampshire. Elliot is charged with three counts of Reckless Conduct, Class B Felony and Resisting Detention, Class A Misdemeanor.

On March 25, 2020 at 3:52 pm, officers responded to the area of Pine Street and Manatee Avenue in Nashua for the report of a person shooting a firearm. Contact was made with Steven Elliott at 256 Pine Street after he initially retreated into his residence refusing to comply with orders from an officer. Elliot was then taken into custody. Detectives furthered this investigation and determined Elliott had discharged a rifle multiple times in the backyard area of 256 Pine Street placing several nearby residents in danger. This area of Pine Street is within a compact residential neighborhood with homes in close proximity to one another. No one was injured during this incident. The firearm believed to be involved was seized.

Elliott was released on personal recognizance bail and is scheduled to be arraigned at the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South on April 30, 2020. Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in jail, exclusive of fines.
