On May 15, 2020, the Manchester Police Department arrested Jalen Juwan Miller, age 26, of 28 Railroad Square, apt. 17, Nashua, New Hampshire on an arrest warrant for First Degree Assault - Class A Felony which was issued by the Nashua Police Department.

On May 13, 2020 at 3:21 p.m., members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to the area of Main Street and Water Street for the report of shots fired. Upon further investigation, it was determined that a 30 year old male had been shot in the foot during an altercation with a male who is known to him. The male was treated on scene with non-life threatening injuries. Detectives furthered the investigation and determined that a Jalen Juwan Miller, age 26, was responsible for the shooting. As a result an arrest warrant was completed charging Miller with First Degree Assault, Class A Felony. Following Miller's arrest on May 15, 2020, he was additionally charged with two counts of Reckless Conduct—Class B Felony.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years of imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Miller was held on preventative detention and transported to the Hillsborough County House of Corrections pending his scheduled arraignment at Hillsborough County Superior Court- Southern District on May 18, 2020.
