On May 6, 2020, at 12:22 P.M., members of the Uniform Field Operations Bureau, arrested Danielle Grundhoff, age 26, of No Fixed Address, Nashua, New Hampshire. Grundhoff is charged with Burglary, Class B Felony, Reckless Conduct with a Deadly Weapon – Domestic Violence, Class B Felony, and Conduct after an Accident, Class A Misdemeanor.

At approximately 11:40 A.M., the Nashua Police Department responded to a local residence for the report of a domestic dispute. Upon arrival, it was learned that a female, identified as Danielle Grundhoff, had broken into the residence and while leaving the scene, drove her vehicle into another occupied vehicle. Grundhoff and the victims are known to each other and there were no injuries during this incident.

Detectives from the Special Investigations Division furthered the investigation. As a result of the investigation, Grundhoff was arrested and charged with Burglary, Class B Felony, Reckless Conduct with a Deadly Weapon – Domestic Violence, Class B Felony, and Conduct after an Accident, Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Grundhoff was held on preventive detention and is scheduled to be arraigned in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South on May 7, 2020.
