On August 07, 2020 at 3:31 P.M., members of the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing (POP) Unit, arrested Patrick Tobin, age 23, of 90 Brook Street, Wellesley, Massachusetts. Tobin is charged with Certain Uses of Computer Services Prohibited, Attempted Felonious Sexual Assault, and Indecent Exposure and Lewdness all Class B Felonies.

In August of 2020 members of the Special Investigations Division began an investigation into the sexual exploitation of children on the internet where a subject, identified as Tobin was communicating with a person he believed to be a child. As a result of the investigation, on August 07, 2020 Tobin was arrested in Nashua.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Tobin was released on personal recognizance bail and will appear in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South at a future date.

The Nashua Police Department is an affiliate of the Internet Crimes against Children (ICAC) Task Force, working to combat child exploitation in New Hampshire.
