On June 18, 2020 at approximately 5:32 PM, members of the Nashua Police Department Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Benjamin Galucki, age 25, for Second Degree Assault- Domestic Violence.

On June 18, 2020 at approximately 7:10 a.m., patrol officers from the Nashua Police Department were dispatched to a residence in Nashua, New Hampshire for the report of a domestic assault. The victim, who is known to Galucki, stated that she had been assaulted by him. The victim sustained minor injury as a result of the assault and she received medical treatment at an area hospital.

Detectives from the Special Investigations Division furthered this investigation and learned that the victim was assaulted numerous times by Galucki. As a result of this investigation, Galucki was subsequently charged with: Second Degree Assault- Domestic Violence, a Class B Felony, thirteen counts of Simple Assault- Domestic Violence, a Class A Misdemeanor, and Criminal Mischief, a Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class B Felony is punishable up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable up to one year in County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Galucki was transferred to the Hillsborough County Jail pending his arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court South on June 19, 2020.
