On May 13, 2020 at 3:21 p.m., members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to the area of Main Street and Water Street for the report of shots fired. Upon further investigation, it was determined that a 30 year old male had been shot in the foot during an altercation with a male who is known to him. The male was treated on scene with non-life threatening injuries. Detectives furthered the investigation and determined that a Jalen Juwan Miller, age 26, was responsible for the shooting. As a result an arrest warrant was completed charging Miller with First Degree Assault, Class A Felony. Miller is depicted in the picture below and he was last seen wearing tan shorts and a white t-shirt. Although this appears to be an isolated incident, Miller should be considered armed and dangerous. If seen, please contact the Nashua Police Department and do not approach him.
