On January 12, 2020, at approximately 5:40 pm, the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau, Patrol Division, arrested Cameron Riley, 33, of 12 Dover Street, Meredith, New Hampshire.

On January 3, 2020, the Nashua Police Department was alerted by the Moultonborough, New Hampshire Police Department of a domestic assault that occurred within the City of Nashua during the late evening hours of January 2, 2020. The victim, who is known to Riley, reported being assaulted numerous times and having personal items damaged. The investigation was furthered by the Special Investigation Division's Domestic Violence Unit. Based upon the results of the investigation, an arrest warrant was issued for Riley for Second Degree Assault-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony. Riley was also charged with eight counts of Domestic Violence: Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor, two counts of Criminal Mischief, Class A Misdemeanor and two counts of Domestic Violence: False Imprisonment, Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class B Felony is punishable up to 7 years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable up to 1 year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Riley was released on bail with an arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court South on January 23, 2020.
