On May 27, 2020 at 3:51 p.m., members of the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing Unit arrested Brandon Maloney, age 22, of No Fixed Address, Nashua, New Hampshire 03060. Brandon was charged with two (2) counts, Theft by Unauthorized Taking or Transfer; Firearm – Class A Felony.

On March 16, 2020, the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to a Skyview Avenue residence for the report of a theft from a motor vehicle. Amongst other articles stolen from the motor vehicle, a Ruger SR9C 9mm semi-automatic pistol was stolen. On April 15, 2020, the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to a Hills Ferry Road residence for the report of a theft from a motor vehicle. Amongst other articles stolen from the motor vehicle, a Smith and Wesson 1911 .40 caliber semi-automatic pistol was stolen. Detectives from the Nashua Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division were assigned to further the investigation. As a result, Brandon Maloney was identified as being responsible for the thefts from Skyview Drive and Hills Ferry Road, along with several other thefts from motor vehicles throughout the City of Nashua. This investigation is ongoing at this time.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years of imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Maloney was held on \$200.00 cash only bail pending his arraignment in the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on Thursday, May 28, 2020.
