On January 27, 2020 at 2:45 P.M., members of the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing (POP) Unit, arrested Wayne Babineau, age 56, of 66 Heald Street, Pepperell, Massachusetts. Babineau is charged with Certain Uses of Computer Services Prohibited, Class B Felony and Attempted Felonious Sexual Assault, Class B Felony.

In October of 2019 members of the Special Investigations Division began an investigation into the sexual exploitation of children on the internet where a subject, identified as Babineau, was communicating with a person he believed to be a child. As a result of the investigation, on January 27, 2020 Babineau was arrested after traveling to Nashua.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Babineau was released on personal recognizance bail and is scheduled to be arraigned in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South on February 06, 2020.

The Nashua Police Department is an affiliate of the Internet Crimes against Children (ICAC) Task Force, working to combat child exploitation in New Hampshire.
