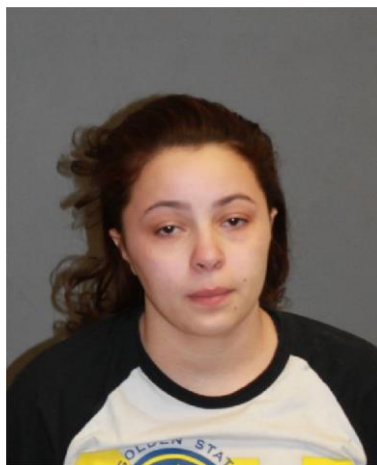
On January 27, 2020, at 6:43 p.m., members of the Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to Verizon Wireless, at 258 Daniel Webster Highway, Nashua, New Hampshire for a reported fraud. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with Janita Randall, age 20, of 172 Hayward Street, Manchester, New Hampshire. After an initial investigation, Randall was placed under arrest and charged with Attempt Theft by Deception, Excess of \$1,500 - Class A Felony, Identity Fraud – Class A Felony and Possession of False Identification – Class A Misdemeanor.

Detectives from the Criminal Investigation Division furthered this investigation and determined Randall entered the store and attempted to fraudulently obtain merchandise valued in excess of \$1,500.00, while utilizing false identification to pose as another.

Randall was released on \$500.00 cash bail and is scheduled to be arraigned at the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South on February 6, 2020.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines.
