On March 9, 2020 at approximately 4:48 p.m., members of the Nashua Police Department arrested Emily Leduc, age 26, of 104 Pine Street Apartment 2, Nashua, New Hampshire. Leduc is charged with Reckless Conduct, Class B Felony.

On March 7, 2020 at approximately 2:00 a.m., officers responded to the area of 104 Pine Street for the report of a disturbance involving a large group where a possible gunshot was fired. The group had dispersed upon police arrival. Evidence was located in the area indicating a firearm was discharged. There was no damage or injuries reported as a result of the discharge of the firearm. Detectives furthered the investigation. Leduc was identified as the individual responsible for discharging a single round from a firearm into the air during the disturbance. An arrest warrant was obtained and Leduc turned herself in without incident. Police have recovered the firearm believed to be involved.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Leduc was released on personal recognizance bail pending arraignment on March 19, 2020 at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South.
