On April 13, 2021 at approximately 10:10 am, Nashua Police Patrol Officers arrested Jennifer Nocera, age 48, of 31 Pelham Street, Nashua, NH on an active arrest warrant charging her with three counts of Identity Fraud, Class A Felony.

On November 4, 2019, the Nashua Police Department was notified by a local resident that numerous credit card accounts had been opened in his name by someone without his permission. The accounts were opened and used to incur debt under the victim's name between March and June 2016. The victim did not become aware of the accounts until 2018 and he attempted to resolve the matter before involving the police. The investigation was furthered by Detectives assigned to the Criminal Investigation Division. During the course of the investigation Jennifer Nocera, who is known to the victim, was identified as the suspect. It was determined Jennifer Nocera used the victim's personal information to apply for three separate credit cards. The cards were successfully opened and Jennifer Nocera subsequently used the credit card accounts for her own benefit. Based on the information received during the course of the investigation, Detectives applied for and were granted an arrest warrant charging Jennifer Nocera with Identity Fraud, Class A Felony.

Each Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Jennifer Nocera was released on \$500 cash bail pending her arraignment at the Hillsborough Superior Court-South on a date to be determined later.
