On June 05, 2020 at 2:32 P.M., members of the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing Unit, arrested Kyle Buckley, age 25, of 376 Main Street, Apartment 4, Nashua, New Hampshire. Buckley is charged with Certain Uses of Computer Services Prohibited, Class B Felony, Attempted Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault, Special Felony, and two counts of Indecent Exposure and Lewdness, Class B Felonies.

In March of 2020, members of the Special Investigations Division began an investigation into the sexual exploitation of children on the internet where a subject, identified as Buckley was communicating with a person he believed to be a child. As a result of the investigation on June 05, 2020, Buckley was arrested in Nashua.

A Special Felony is punishable by a term of imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Buckley was released on \$5,000 cash or surety bail and is scheduled to be arraigned in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South on July 16, 2020.

The Nashua Police Department is an affiliate of the Internet Crimes against Children (ICAC) Task Force, working to combat child exploitation in New Hampshire.
