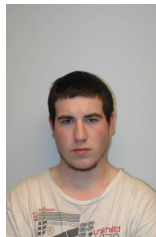
On January 23, 2012 at 12:30 AM, members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operation Bureau arrested Raymond Rodrigues, age 21, of 58 Ash St., Nashua, NH and Christopher Carey, age 17, of 58 ½ West Hollis St., Nashua, NH. Carey is charged with Burglary, a class B Felony, Theft by Unauthorized Taking, class A felony and Resisting Detention, a Class A Misdemeanor. Rodrigues is charged with Criminal Liability for the Conduct of Another to Burglary, class B felony, Theft by Unauthorized Taking, class A felony and Resisting Detention, a Class A Misdemeanor.

On January 23, 2012 at approximately 12:20 AM, the Nashua Police Department received a call for a Burglary at a West Pearl Street business, The Steez Gallery. Officers responded to the area and upon arrival they observed three subjects run from the area of the victim business upon seeing the responding police units. Both suspects were apprehended by Officers after brief foot pursuits and the suspects were identified as Carey and Rodrigues. A check of the business showed that a burglary had been committed, with evidence of forced entry. Several items of merchandise had been stolen from the business and subsequently recovered. Detectives assigned to the Nashua Police Department's Burglary Investigation Unit furthered this incident, which resulted in the charges against both defendants.

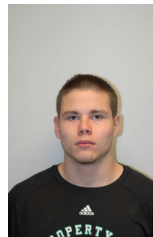
A class A felony is punishable by up to fifteen years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in jail, exclusive of fines. Carey was held at the Nashua Police Department on a five thousand dollar cash or surety bail pending his arraignment at 9th Circuit Court - Nashua District Division on January 24, 2011. Rodrigues was held at the Nashua Police Department on fifteen thousand dollar cash or surety bail pending his arraignment at 9th Circuit Court - Nashua District Division on January 24, 2011.
